I am a naturalist for Five Rivers MetroParks, serving the greater Dayton area. After graduating in 2010 with a B.S., I began my career at Five Rivers MetroParks. While I never dreamed of leading owl prowls, birding field trips, or creek studies, I now find myself at the heart of environmental education. Without any formal interpretation background, my supervisor had his work cut out for him as he trained and mentored me. Honestly, I can't imagine having any other supervisor than Joshua York. From July of 2010 until now, I have had the honor and the pleasure of working as Joshua York's naturalist, connecting children and adults to nature in ways I could have never imagined.

From day one, Joshua had an incredible enthusiasm for teaching and mentoring, and it was clear that while he loved delivering programs, mentoring was his favorite aspect of being an Education Supervisor.
